THE CHAIRMAN: Now we will hold that motion in abeyance until we have considered Section 2, discuss Section 2.

Mrs. Bothe?

MRS. BOTHE: Proposed Section 2 would read:
The General Assembly shall provide for a statewide system
of free public schools sufficient for the education of,
and open to, all children of school age.

This carries out what is now contained in

Section 1 of Article VIII. We feel without any doubt that there should be a constitutional mandate requiring the General Assembly to provide for a free education to all children of school age and under the terms we use, they are terms of art in a sense, but we don't feel that they are litigation breeders in any way, because the concept of free public schools implies it has been accepted as meaning the elementary school system or secondary school system, I think is the correct word. We felt that the Section should be segregated from the intent of the section as expressed in Section 1 because it is a different concept. The one merely encourages the State to provide
