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foreseeable future, and it is also foreseeable that it will be open to nursery school on the other end of the spectrum. However, we wanted to leave the concept open so that the secondary school system could be flexible.

MR. MILLER: You don't mention secondary schools.

MRS. BOTHE: Public schools are recognized as being secondary schools in constitutional language.

MR. MILLER: I don't think they are frozen at that, are they?

MRS. BOTHE: They are not frozen, but after doing some research into the area particularly in the old Constitution, the Committee felt that this Section would pertain to the secondary school system of the State.

MRS. BOTHE: Yes, uniform, free Statewide
