so that people are taken care of in Maryland under a variety

MR. MILLER: Under the statutes. We are writing the new Constitution. That is the point.

THE CHAIRMAN: I take it the position of the Committee and Mrs. Bothe is that the Constitution should require the Legislature to maintain a system of free public schools for persons of school age but does not require an adult education program. It does not prohibit an adult education program. Any further questions?

Mr. Clagett?

MR. CLAGETT: This may be a little late because it really applies to Section 1, but I would like to ask Mrs. Bothe why the word, people, is used at the end of that Section instead of citizens of this State.

MRS. BOTHE: That term was chosen in reference to citizens of this State for the reason that we felt that people encompassed everything that the State could offer,
