JUDGE ADKINS: Well, I think there is this to be accomplished, but I don't think this responsibility, as I said, should be imposed on the General Assembly. It is not a sole function of the Legislature. It is the responsibility of the elected officials of the State of Maryland and should not be put solely on the General Assembly. It is equally, if no more so, the responsibility of the Chief Executive.

MR. CLAGETT: We have made it his responsibility in the budget provisions, so why keep on saying so?

THE CHAIRMAN: I suppose Judge Adkins' answer would be that the Governor has a responsibility for the passage of legislation in almost the same way as the Legislature.

Mrs. Freedlander?

MRS. FREEDLANDER: Mr. Chairman, I feel that if we believe in the separation of powers, there are certain times in this Constitution where we should mention the Governor shall and certain times when we should mention the General Assembly shall, and in each instance, the General Assembly must through appropriations through the
