other portion of this is not free. The second portion is not free, and I do not object. I favor adult education. I am a proponent of adult education, but I do not feel adult education should necessarily be free. I think some things people should pay for at least in part. I think children should not pay, but others should pay.

THE CHAIRMAN: Dr. Bard, may I ask you a question as an educator and ask the same of Dr. Burdette?

Would you consider a student in one of the professional schools at the University of Maryland, for instance, as a person of school age, the Law School, Medical School, Dental School?

DR. BARD: In answer to your question, I would certainly consider one in our particular school as an individual of school age, yes.

THE CHAIRMAN: So that the effect of your motion in your mind, then, would be to require the State by the Constitution to maintain a system of at least community college?

DR. BARD: Might be, but not necessarily so. This offers the possibility for it to be so. As a matter
