DR. BARD: That is right, it should be restated in the second sentence. After reapportionment following the 1970 census, number of members of the Legislature shall be as prescribed by law and then the rest of it continues, number of Senators. We would have to insert that clause again.

MR. SCANLAN: The feeling was by adding seven to the House, raising the ceiling, there would be some chance that each county would have at least one. This is debatable. That is why the seven were put in there. I think some of the Committee members feel even with 150 there will come a time when not every county would be entitled to a seat in the House of Delegates. This was an attempt to try to accommodate each county but at the same time without making the House unmanageable in size. I think that is it.

DR. BARD: That is correct.
