DR. BURDETTE: Couldn't we solve this problem somewhat by taking out the word, by law, after, provide, and put in, education and open to all of school age, as provided by law? Does that help it so that the school age could be provided by law?

THE CHAIRMAN: It would help it, but I think it might have other adverse effects.

 $\ensuremath{\mathsf{MRS}}.$  BOTHE: It would take the whole mandate out of meaning.

MRS. FREEDLANDER: Yes.

on the motion to delete from the first clause the word, children, so the first clause as emended would read, The State shall provide by law for a Statewide system of free public schools sufficient for the education of and open to all of school age. All in favor, signify by a show of hands. Contrary? The motion is lost, 4 to 19. Is there any further motion with respect to Section 2? Section 3. I am going to suggest that Section 3 be presented by the Chairman of the Committee and that we then take a coffee break before discussion.
