The Committee proposes that a new Section be added to the Maryland Constitution covering an area that has not heretofore appeared there and that it read as follows: The University of Maryland shall be managed by the Regents of the University of Maryland in accordance with law, and the Regents shall have exclusive general supervision of the institution and the control and direction of all expenditures from the institution's funds.
