of thing that should be permitted to happen in the State. Once the funds have been appropriated, we keep in mind, not me, the University or the Committee or anyone else proposes that the University be given a free hand with the State's Treasury. The issue involved here is simply who is going to watch what funds are allocated and how they can be best met to meet the needs of the State's only university, and one of the major ones in the country.

we take the coffee break, let me just say this, so you can be thinking about it. From comments and discussions I have heard, there are at least four and maybe more points of view that various Members of the Commission want to express and to have votes on. They include the Committee's recommendation for autonomy of the University of Maryland, opposition to University of Maryland, or any other group, broadening the Committee's provision to include autonomy, not only for the University of Maryland, but also for Board of State Colleges, and I gather for certain other colleges, how far I don't know; and fourthly, to include the public school system or at least the Board
