2 I don't know how we can quite fairly put up all
3 of these propositions but certainly we will endeavor to
4 have everybody who wants to have a vote on any of them
5 have the opportunity to do so. In order to do it, we
6 v'll have to proceed as orderly as possibly. We will have
7 to follow the rules of debate of which I remind you each
8 person on each motion speaks but once except the mover and
9 speaks for not more than three minutes and the mover closes.

10 So if you want to speak on any of these pro-
11 posals, and I gather many of you do, if you will utilize
12 the time of the coffee break to formulate your thoughts
13 so you can state them succinctly and briefly.

14 MRS. BOTHE: I did not make any comment on the
15 Committee's recommendations, negative recommendations
16 because it was my understanding that you wanted us to go
17 through the positive proposals. Of course, if a motion
18 is made on the subject of other institutions' recognition,
19 I would want to present the Committee's views.
