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THE CHAIRMAN: Don't discuss. Just ask the questions at this point. Any further questions, Mr.

MR. SCANLAN: Not at the moment.

THE CHAIRMAN: Mr. Clagett?

MR. CLAGETT: Article 11 dealing with political subdivisions, the General Assembly has the power to create, abolish and so forth, and we mandate political counties, cities and so forth. We do provide for other political cities. Is that a group that would come within that classification, other civil divisions?

MRS. BOTHE: You are speaking now of the other recommendations of your Committee.

MR. CLAGETT: Here is my question basically: Are we here mandating a form of civil division in addition to counties and cities as provided for in Article 11.

MRS. BOTHE: You are talking about apples and oranges. We are mandating a form of division, but it is not anologous to the political subdivisions of which you are speaking. It is not a political subdivision. Τt is a department of government.
