

1 to a university at one time where the charter antedated  
2 that of the State and the police and the city could not come  
3 in and make an arrest because it was off limits. Are we  
4 trying to create something like that in this constitution-  
5 al autonomy they are getting?

6 MRS. BOTHE: Not at all. I assume you are speak-  
7 ing of a private university which is on private property  
8 and which the State couldn't enter on the property.

9 MR. MILLER: The grant came from the king as  
10 I remember it, and the State didn't have any say about it.

11 MRS. BOTHE: If a student doesn't keep proper  
12 hours in the dormitory, this would be the power to dis-  
13 cipline him with the University exclusively. However, if  
14 the student rapes a girl in the next dorm, this is not  
15 within the province of the University.

16 THE CHAIRMAN: Judge Adkins?

17 JUDGE ADKINS: Mr. Chairman, if I understand  
18 the import of this Section, the residual control that the  
19 people of the State would reserve to themselves would be  
20 basically the power of appropriation. I wonder if
