that surplus reverts back to the State.

JUDGE ADKINS: Would that be true under this proposed amendment?

MR. CASE: Yes.

I think a lot of people don't MRS. BOTHE: understand that once an appropriation has been made, it cannot be diverted under ordinary circumstances without a budget bill or without the permission of the Budget In other words, if an appropriation for ten teachers of physical science has been made to the University of Maryland, and they decide that they can only hire five teachers but they would rather pay them twice as much, the University of Maryland is free to spend twice as much for half the teachers without the Without the autonomy, however, they would have teachers. to go back and get authorization for this action and wouldn't be able to take it independently. It is not a question of taking money. It is a question of being able to juggle appropriations after the money is made available without surveillance from outside.
