2 which can be used without having to go back to the  
3 appropriating authority, to have an amendment?

4 MR. CASE: There never have been, Congressman.  
5 In other words, is what you are saying a general sort of  
6 contingency fund that can be used for any purpose?

7 MR. MILLER: Yes.

8 MR. CASE: I haven't seen the latest draft of  
9 it, but for the first time the Board of Regents requested  
10 such a fund this year.

11 MR. MILLER: In the Federal appropriation,  
12 within 10 per cent the head of the department can supple-  
13 ment one to take out the other, within 10 per cent.

14 MR. CASE: We have no such provision.

15 THE CHAIRMAN: I would like to go back to your  
16 last answer to Judge Adkins for the record, to Judge  
17 Adkins. He asked you if in this Section 3/<sup>you</sup>would make any  
18 change, and you said, No change at all. I take it you  
19 mean no change in the present practice but the present  
20 statute is statutory.
