procedure would be any difference.

 THE CHAIRMAN: In other words, I take it what you are saying is that under the Autonomy Act of 1952 as amended, the institution now has the control and direction of all expenditures from the institution's funds?

MR. CASE: That is right.

THE CHAIRMAN: Can you tell us whether the language is the same?

MR. CASE: I don't think it is quite as precise in Article 77, Section 249(e). I have it right before me. It is not the same language.

THE CHAIRMAN: Mr. Martineau?

MR. MARTINEAU: I would like to, I guess this question goes more to Mr. Case than anyone else, in contrasting this recommendation with that with respect to the Judiciary, I am wondering why you feel that it is necessary for the independence of the University to have this control over the method of spending funds once they are allowed for in the budget, and the University can then spend them for whatever purpose the University sees fit, and yet at the same time, it is not, apparently
