

1 Committee proposes it, would the University have complete  
2 control over the establishment of tuition, the amount of  
3 tuition?

4 MRS. BOTHE: Yes.

5 THE CHAIRMAN: Would the University, by which  
6 I mean the Regents, have complete control over the location  
7 of branches of the University?

8 MRS. BOTHE: Yes, it would, subject, of course,  
9 to the Legislature's appropriation. There is a great  
10 deal of discussion about what would happen if the Univer-  
11 sity didn't use the funds for the purpose represented in  
12 the Legislature, but I think it has to be kept in mind  
13 that the University must come back every year to ask for  
14 more, and if they represent that they want funds to put  
15 up a fine arts building and then put the thing down in  
16 Cumberland or something, the next time they ask for a  
17 building, I doubt if they will be so successful. This  
18 check is always there, and the likelihood of abuse from  
19 what we understand, there has been virtually none under  
20 the Autonomy Act.
