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the University of Maryland found a place where there are buildings, still they come to the Legislature and this is not really the exclusive control that some people envision.

THE CHAIRMAN: I am just trying to get the point in the record as to the intended meaning of these particular provisions. Mrs. Bothe, you said in answer to earlier questions that under this language you think the State could provide that all the University funds could be put in a certain bank account or subject to certain controls.

Did I understand that correctly?

MRS. EOTHE: Yes, I believe the present Autonomy Act calls for deposit with the State Treasury.

THE CHAIRMAN: I am not thinking of that. I am thinking of the language of the Section. Is it the intention of the Committee that in saying the Regents shall have exclusive control and direction of all expenditures from the institution's funds, that that is nevertheless subject to the power of the Legislature to prescribe safeguarding controls?
