

1 MRS. BOTHE: That is right.

2 MR. CASE: That is the law now.

3 THE CHAIRMAN: Now, would the, under this  
4 language, would the Committee feel that, and this follows  
5 a question of Mr. Clagett's, that if the Legislature  
6 passed a general law applicable to educational institu-  
7 tions that it would or would not be applicable to the  
8 University of Maryland if it dealt with the matter of,  
9 that could be within the term, general supervision of the  
10 institution?

11 MRS. BOTHE: It would not be unconstitutional.

12 THE CHAIRMAN: So the answer to Mr. Clagett's  
13 question is that the general law would be subject to  
14 this limitation. The final question, if, under this  
15 language, the Legislature appropriated a total amount for  
16 the support of the University for the next year, I take  
17 it that the University's total funds would then be the  
18 amount appropriated plus receipts from tuition, plus re-  
19 cepts from Federal Government, endowments, and so forth?  
20 Would the meaning of this last clause be that the Regents  
21 could spend the total sums so appropriated for any purpose
