THE CHAIRMAN: Now, would the, under this language, would the Committee feel that, and this follows a question of Mr. Clagett's, that if the Legislature passed a general law applicable to educational institutions that it would or would not be applicable to the University of Maryland if it dealt with the matter of, that could be within the term, general supervision of the institution?

MRS BOTHE: It would not be unconstitutional.

So the answer to Mr. Clagett's.

question is that the general law would be subject to this limitation. The final question, if, under this language, the Legislature appropriated a total amount for the support of the University for the next year, I take it that the University's total funds would then be the amount appropriated plus receipts from tuition, plus receipts from Federal Government, endowments, and so forth? Would the meaning of this last clause be that the Regents could spend the total sums so appropriated for any purpose
