into legislative districts for the election of members of the House of Delegates and should also be divided into legislative districts for election of members of the Senate. Each district to consist of compact and contiguous territory within limitation because of its system, county, or city lines. All of this would not go into the constitution. We would have a shorter statement in the constitution.

We would, however, if this Commission thought it were advisable, include this sentence. Districts should be so nearly equal in population that there should not be variation in the population of each district of more than 5 per cent from the mean -- or average, you can add. Later on it says mean, not average. We are using mean and average as synonymous but not median and average as synonymous.

There is an error on Page 13. Somebody typed this inaccurately on the fifth line from the bottom.

I could comment further in regard to this 5 per cent.

One other point. I think we covered this. There should be no provision in the new constitution
