2 to the Law School, his question is, could the Regents under
3 this language use it for salaries, for instance?

4 MR. CASE: They could not.

5 THE CHAIRMAN: Under this language?

6 MR. CASE: That is right, they could not.

7 THE CHAIRMAN: Can you tell us why?

8 MRS. BOTHE: I am not sure under this language
9 that this would be supervision of the institution and
10 control of expenditures from its funds. I assume this would
11 be a capital appropriation for a specific purpose which was
12 not part of the general funds of the University.

13 THE CHAIRMAN: Well, use a different illustra-
14 tion.

15 Mr. Haile?

16 MR. HAILE: Suppose the condition of the appro-
17 priation is that the President of the University's salary
18 not exceed \$250,000 a year. Would this prohibit any
19 such condition upon the appropriation?

20 MRS. BOTHE: If the Legislature passed a law
21 that the University's salary couldn't exceed \$250,000.
