3 questions? Then, we will proceed to debate. I am un-
4 certain as to the best way to proceed. I was thinking of
5 it during the coffee break, and it occurred to me that
6 perhaps the best way would be to consider motions to
7 amend what is proposed by the Committee before you con-
8 sider motions either to approve or reject. What is your
9 feeling?

12 presented and also in view of Mr. Case's commitment to
13 be elsewhere and his interest in this topic, I would like
14 to move the adoption of Section 3 and have that matter
15 passed upon and then have any amendments which may be
16 offered debated and acted on.
