THE CHAIRMAN: That is a debate perhaps. We will give you the opportunity to ask that. Any further questions? Then, we will proceed to debate. I am uncertain as to the best way to proceed. I was thinking of it during the coffee break, and it occurred to me that perhaps the best way would be to consider motions to amend what is proposed by the Committee before you consider motions either to approve or reject. What is your feeling?

MRS. BOTHE: Mr. Chairman, I would suggest, in view of the method by which the Report has been presented and also in view of Mr. Case's commitment to be elsewhere and his interest in this topic, I would like to move the adoption of Section 3 and have that matter passed upon and then have any amendments which may be offered debated and acted on.

THE CHAIRMAN: The difficulty is that somebody moves to amend that by amendment, you would get/back the same way.
