2 DR. BARD: I so move and here is what I should
3 like to submit as a substitute.

4 MR. BOND: Out of order. We have offered two
5 motions, and here is a third.

6 MR. SCANLAN: There is only one motion on the
7 floor.

8 MR. BOND: Mrs. Bothe attempted one.

9 THE CHAIRMAN: No, she made a suggestion.

10 MRS. BOTHE: The motion on the floor is the
11 way the Committee would like to proceed.

12 THE CHAIRMAN: Let me, before we consider
13 any amendment or substitute and without attempting to
14 rule anybody out of order, we are under pressure of
15 time. I am not merely thinking of the private engage-
16 ments of the Members, but of the Commission. We have
17 three other Reports to get through this afternoon, and
18 we have to eliminate if we possibly can waste motions and
19 use less motions. I take it, Mrs. Bothe, that it makes no
20 difference to you whether the debate is on a motion to
21 approve or a motion to delete.
