8 MR. SCANLAN: I am very much opposed to elevat-
9 ing the University of Maryland in the words of Mrs. Bothe,
10 to another constitutional department. I went along with
11 the elevation of the Public School System in effect so
12 far as budgetary proceedings are concerned to a consti-
13 tutional department of government. At least there, there
14 was some justification. The presentation of the Committee
15 this morning has in my mind, includes not a scintilla of
16 justification except as Mrs. Bothe again put it, we have
17 to take Dr. Elkins' word for it. Well, I don't.
