with reference to the counting or exclusion of persons teaching at or attending educational institutions. Whether there should be single member districts or multiple member districts should be left to the determination of the Legislature itself provided, however, that if the Legislature were to decide upon multiple member districts, there should be no more than six

delegates from any one district created for House

There are two points here.

DR. BARD:

No more than two Senators. THE CHAIRMAN:

That is right. Two points here

I think, are significant. One that I believe would not create debate. That is that each district consist of compact and contiguous territory. Then this element of 5 per cent variation from the mean which you may want to talk to. Then secondly the matter of multiple member districts. We could either set up a ceiling or leave the ceiling to the State Legislature in regard to the number in each multiple member district.
