2 JUDGE ADKINS: I guess it is maybe too late  
3 for questions, but I am confused by this whole problem.  
4 The surgery that has been suggested here is pretty  
5 radical. I wonder if there is any merit in leaving in  
6 some reference to the University of Maryland and its  
7 Regencies with some reference to its controls, but, how-  
8 ever, limiting the nature of those controls to a non-  
9 exclusive control? Is there any merit from the point  
10 of view of proponents of Section 3 in having a reference  
11 to the University of Maryland in the Constitution without  
12 necessarily going to the actual extent of Section 3 and  
13 having complete constitutional autonomy?
