in this country, that an oligo may get shold of it and do away with autonomy and so on. My answer is that is the old argument of burning down the house to get rid of the rats. There is no reason at all to suspect this is going to happen because of the preeminence of the University, and our right today in this State. But I say to you, if that ever did happen, there are plenty of procedures left in the Constitution to get rid of the Presi-Bear in mind, ladies and gentlemen, that this autonomy requests a very restrictive thing. It is not giving the University a blank check. All it is asking is that the University be permitted to manage its own affairs after the appropriations have been made. All of the safeguards are here and more that deal with educational institutions other than the University. They are all here, and in my judgment, this is the very least that ought to appear in the Constitution. I say to you that if you want the issue / simply this, if you want a great university, something that we all can be proud of in this State, then this is the right way to go about it. If you want the humdrum experience we had from 1920 to 1952,
