statutory autonomy for these institutions. 1 THE CHAIRMAN: Just a second. Is there a 2 second? 3 DR. BARD: I second. DR. JENKINS: The obvious purpose for having 5 this in the record is that when and if the issue comes up 6 in the General Assembly, it will have some effect on the 7 opponents of autonomy. 8 THE CHAIRMAN: Any further discussion? 9 10 Mr. Bond? MR. BOND: I just wanted to ask --11 DR. JENKINS: As this is stated, it doesn't 12 say we approve it necessarily, either. 13 THE CHAIRMAN: Mr. Bond? 14 MR. BOND: What is statutory autonomy? 15 DR. JERKINS: Provided by statute. 16 MR. BOND: You heard Mr. Case say it could be 17 taken away at any time. I wonder if that means anything. 18 THE CHAIRMAN: Mr. Sayre? 19 MR. SAYRE: Would Dr. Jenkins be willing to 20 have a slight amendment that would have the effect of, 21
