2 earmarked for the use of the schools. They are of such  
3 small consequence that they hardly need constitutional  
4 protection.

5 MRS. FREEDLANDER: A point of order, Mr. Chair-  
6 man. I feel this is out of order since we adopted the  
7 provision of the Report, and it was to be a substitute  
8 for the Article as it appears in the Constitution. I  
9 don't see the point at this time.

10 THE CHAIRMAN: Let me make the suggestion. I  
11 don't think it is out of order, but I don't think you  
12 need discuss these positions extensively unless someone  
13 wants to. You might just state the recommendation.

14 MRS. BOTHE: The recommendation is that there  
15 be no provision similar to that contained in the present  
16 Article VIII, Section 5, that the school funds of the  
17 State be kept inviolate.
