present during the debate on the question and could not 1 vote absentee persons. There are others who are not here 2 today and might have contrary views, so I would have 3 to rule your suggestion out of order. Is there any 4 further recommendation, Mrs. Bothe? That is the end of 5 6 it. I think D has inferentially MRS. BOTHE: 7 8 covered. THE CHAIRMAN: D is on Page 12. Any further 9 discussion or question? If not, it is considered as 10 Section E is on Page 14. 11 MRS. BOTHE: That may have been approved by 12 the Commission at the July meeting. The subject was 13 raised so that recommendation is that there be no 14 reference to private aid to education in the Constitution. 15 In the July meeting that recommendation as it now appears 16
