3 belief among Commission Members that we have done any-
4 thing which would preclude State aid to private institu-
5 tions, we should take further action. I feel the entire
6 action of the Committee was done toward the end that
7 we should remain silent on the point of it, but not to
8 prohibit State aid to private institution?.

12 DR. BARD: I felt Mrs. Freedlander's substi-
13 tute provided for that if the State so desired it. That
14 could be taken care of through the substitution motion
15 which Mrs. Freedlander moved and which was subsequently
16 passed, State aid for private institutions can be taken
17 care of.
