want to call the Commission's attention to the entire purport of Section E here for the reason if there is any belief among Commission Members that we have done anything which would preclude State aid to private institutions, we should take further action. I feel the entire action of the Committee was done toward the end that we should remain silent on the point of it, but not to prohibit State aid to private institution?.

THE CHAIRMAN: Any further comment or discussion? Anything further?

Dr. Bard?

DR. BARD: I felt Mrs. Freedlander's substitute provided for that if the State so desired it. That could be taken care of through the substitution motion which Mrs. Freedlander moved and which was subsequently passed, State aid for private institutions can be taken care of.

THE CHAIRMAN: Yes. Any further comment or discussion? If not, that concludes the consideration of the Fifth Report of the Committee on Miscellaneous Provisions.
