

1 MRS. BOTHE: It would be agreeable if we fol-
2 lowed Judge Adkins' suggestion. In view of the very
3 close vote, I feel it should be done.

4 THE CHAIRMAN: Well then, the motion, as I
5 understand it, is that the subject matter of Section 3 be
6 referred back to the Committee with instructions to report
7 to the next meeting of the Commission a redraft of the
8 Section, and I didn't quite get your qualifying language.

9 JUDGE ADKINS: My qualifying language was that
10 it would not involve the complete autonomy they have pro-
11 posed here since that has been voted down.

12 THE CHAIRMAN: And this be made a special
13 order of business at the next meeting.

14 DR. BARD: The question?

15 THE CHAIRMAN: Has that been seconded?

16 DR. JENKINS: I second it, and I understood him
17 to say special order of business without debate. If that
18 is permissible.
