motion because I don't think this motion, if it is a new 1 2 matter, it should not be without debate. I would be 3 willing to limit the debate. 4 DR. BARD: I have a point of order. Would 5 the maker of the motion be willing to put a period after, 6 redraft of the provision? 7 JUDGE ADKINS: No. 8 DR. BARD: In other words, you are telling 9 them how to redraft it according to your motion? 10 JUDGE ADKINS: I will stand on my motion. 11 THE CHAIRMAN: Any further discussion of the 12 motion? 13 MRS. BOTHE: A point of information. 14 everyone at that meeting be privileged to vote? 15 THE CHAIRMAN: At the next meeting, certainly. 16 It will be a new matter before the Commission at that 17 time. It will not be merely a reconsideration. 18 MR. MILLER: Will it be subject to a point of 19 order if it goes right back to the beginning about putting 20 the University of Maryland in the Constitution?
