are just throwing the gates open, and all we fought and bled and died over here this morning is going down the drain if a new proposition can be brought up. I would suggest we decide it right now.

THE CHAIRMAN: Mr. Clagett?

MR. CLACETT: I would disagree with that,
Mr. Chairman. I think it has been one of the great
revelations and sources of pleasure to all who have participated in the meetings of this Commission from the
beginning up until now, and now is not the end. We have
been able to find common meeting grounds and to resolve
many important issues in a way that was acceptable to all
of us and to foreclose this particular issue as important as it is and as close as the vote is, I think would
be a great mistake because there must be some common
ground and one where we can all go out with a degree of
satisfaction.
