2 bled and died over here this morning is going down the
3 drain if a new proposition can be brought up. I would
4 suggest we decide it right now.

5 THE CHAIRMAN: Mr. Clagett?

6 MR. CLAGETT: I would disagree with that,
7 Mr. Chairman. I think it has been one of the great
8 revelations and sources of pleasure to all who have par-
9 ticipated in the meetings of this Commission from the
10 beginning up until now, and now is not the end. We have
11 been able to find common meeting grounds and to resolve
12 many important issues in a way that was acceptable to all
13 of us and to foreclose this particular issue as impor-
14 tant as it is and as close as the vote is, I think would
15 be a great mistake because there must be some common
16 ground and one where we can all go out with a degree of
17 satisfaction.

18 THE CHAIRMAN: Any further discussion of the
19 motion? Ready for the question? The question arises on
20 the motion to refer to the Committee on Miscellaneous
21 Provisions reconsideration of Section 3 with the request
