express the thought here more clearly we would be happy to receive them. We have done and have almost consistently revised the language to make it more clear and if anyone has any suggestion, we would be happy to receive them. We have no objection to the Committee on Style making any changes they deem appropriate.

Going on to Section 4 the first reference to underscored there in all judicial proceedings was directed at the Commission at the last meeting and the deletion of the word all in the first line was also directed as was the addition of the word by this Constitution. The next changes are shall have, as is, is also a matter of cleaning up the language. In Section B, 4B, we have rephrased the language somewhat to make it clear that the judges are allocated among the counties by law. This was again a matter raised at the last meeting. Skipping on then to --
