the counties by law.

MR. MARTINEAU: Well, the phrase is that, it is intended to mean that the Legislature will provide that Baltimore County there shall be 13 Judges of the Superior Court. In Baltimore City, there shall be 20, and in some other county there will be 1, 2, or 3. That is the purpose.

THE CHAIRMAN: You mean simply the number allocated?

MR. MARTINEAU: Not the individual.

THE CHAIRMAN: What I was thinking was whether or not this would let the Legislature provide by for law, for instance, that there will be 7 Judges in Prince Georges County, 2 of whom should be elected from Charles County and one from St. Marys and one from Calvert and the rest from Prince Georges.

MR. MARTINEAU: I would not think so.

THE CHAIRMAN: That is not intended?

MR. MARTINEAU: Certainly not intended. We are trying to cover the residency requirements. Perhaps this does not express it very well.
