THE CHAIRMAN: Do you need the phrase who shall be allocated among the counties by law at all, does it add anything? Mr. Rodowsky.

MR. RODOWSKY: I think you need something to tie in with the residency requirement further on particularly with the change that was dictated by the Commission that you have not only a residence as a condition of eligiblity for nomination and appointment, but this concept of a principal place of the practice of law and which creates the problem so that you need some concept whereby the particular office to be filled is tied to a particular one of the counties since I think the idea is --

THE CHAIRMAN: I take it you are saying the Legislature shall have the power to determine the number of Judges to be allocated to each county and that is all?

MR. RODOWSKY: And I think if we change the who to which, it might do it because it modifies number and not the person.

THE CHAIRMAN: All right.
