is that the budget of the judiciary is now subject to revision by the executive but not by the Legislature. A further section that was adopted yesterday provides that the budget of the judiciary as submitted by the Governor can be increased by the Legislature but not decreased and that is the same provision that is in the present Constitution.

THE CHAIRMAN: Mr. Bond.

MR. BOND: Point of information, Mr. Chairman. Has this provision as to rule-making power been finally approved by this Committee?

THE CHAIRMAN: Wait just a second. You are on Section 8.

MRS. BOTHE: I am satisfied.

MR. CLAGETT: A question on Section 7.

Is it possible that the Chief Justice could not assign the Chief Judge of the Superior Court the budget making responsibility that has to be submitted to the budget?
