think the words governing practice and procedure is pretty broad. Certainly the Legislature --

THE CHAIRMAN: Wait, go ahead. Don't discuss it, give the point.

MR. BOND: The point I am making is that the Legislature speaks and the court should not be able to overrule the Legislature.

THE CHAIRMAN: The question is submitted to the Commission without debate under our rule as to whether or not you want to reconsider. This is a question which the Commission has acted on in opposite directions in two successive meetings. Are you ready for the question?

DR. BURDETTE: I can't hear. What are we reconsidering?

THE CHAIRMAN: The question that Mr. Bond wants to reconsider is whether in the final analysis the decision of the Legislature or the decision of the court is to be paramount on the matters set out in Section 8 covered by the rule-making power. This was discussed in July. It was voted on in August. It was
