representative to each county and get into the preservation of a representative for each county.

THE CHAIRMAN: In the constitution?

MR. CLAGETT: In the constitution.

THE CHAIRMAN: I think that is a different point from that of Judge Adkins. Maybe we better save that as a separate point. Any further discussion of his point?

DR. BARD: I would like to say that there

has been a good deal said about the fact that the states have the responsibility in respect to carrying out voter registration and in respect to voting. The constitution gave this to the states. For many years, the Supreme Court wouldn't touch it. Now we have said all along that this is a state responsibility. Here we have an opportunity to actually do something within the State of Maryland about this. I would not hold whether it be, I am with Mr. Sayre, 5 per cent or 7 or what have you. What I would hold is for taking our responsibility for clarifying what is not clear. All of us who have worked in this area of redistricting or
