

1 MR. MARTINEAU: Let me read on. Let me
2 finish reading the entire section that we propose and
3 that may answer some of the questions you might have.
4 We then delete the entire next sentence relating to
5 pensions.

6 MRS. FREEDLANDER: Which sentence?

7 MR. MARTINEAU: Provision shall be made
8 by law for pension based on length of service of Judges
9 and their surviving spouses, delete that. Beginning at
10 the bottom of page 10, the last sentence at the bottom
11 of Page 10 going over to the top of Page 11.

12 MR. MILLER: What did you delete?

13 MR. MARTINEAU: The sentence beginning at
14 the bottom of Page 10 beginning with the words provision
15 shall be made by law for the payment of pensions based
16 on length of service to Judges and their surviving
17 spouses. We are deleting that. In the next sentence
18 beginning with the words the same compensation we are
19 deleting the phrase including pensions. In other words,
20 the 4th and 5th words in the first sentence on Page
21 11 are deleted, the words including pensions. Then at
