

1 MR. MARTINEAU: No, what they would do, it
2 seems to me, is to change the payment for length of
3 service. In other words, they wouldn't arbitrarily say
4 \$5000. They would say each Judge shall receive so much
5 for each year of service and that is how they would
6 increase it.

7 MR. SCANLAN: In other words, any pension
8 awarded to retired Judges would have some relation to
9 length of service?

10 MR. MARTINEAU: Yes.

11 THE CHAIRMAN: Mr. Miller.

12 MR. MILLER: There may be something else
13 in here but it occurs to me the way this is worded it
14 says no Judge shall engage in the practice of law.

15 THE CHAIRMAN: We'll wait before you get
16 to that paragraph. Let's see if there are any more
17 questions as to the first paragraph.

18 MR. MARTINEAU: Want me to answer your
19 question? Our idea is --

20 THE CHAIRMAN: The record is not going to
21 show what question you are answering.
