2 Judges are going to receive and the Committee has not
3 made any decision on this. We are going to have to
4 decide whether those Judges who are in office and who
5 went on the Bench with the idea of receiving a particular
6 amount of money that was not able to be reduced are
7 going to be frozen in at that salary level. I don't
8 know frankly what the Committee is going to recommend
9 on this. My own inclination would be that any Judge
10 who is on the Bench right now receiving a salary of
11 a particular amount of money should be entitled to receive
12 that as long as he remains in office. Of course, any
13 Judge coming on after the adoption of the new Constitu-
14 tion will receive the salary which is set by the Legis-
15 lature. This will be something that the Commission can
16 vote on at a later time when it considers the schedule
17 that we will propose.
