3 DR. BURDETTE: The way to do that is say in
4 office because somebody is going to argue a retired
5 Judge is still a Judge.

6 THE CHAIRMAN: Particularly in view of
7 the provision for recalling retired Judges.

8 MR. DELLA: Couldn't you have no Judge
9 while in office?

10 MR. MARTINEAU: Couldn't your Committee take
11 that into consideration?

12 MR. MARTINEAU: Yes, sir.

13 JUDGE ADKINS: I think the pension law would
14 probably make it exactly. I think that is how it would
15 be handled rather than putting the prohibition in the
16 Constitution, that the law establish the pension fund and
17 would provide it would cease upon the retired Judge
18 engaging in any prohibitive activity.

19 JUDGE ADKINS: You can't do that because you
20 have given him a constitutional guarantee that their
21 pension won't be reduced so you have to put it in here.
