

1 THE CHAIRMAN: I assume the purpose is to  
2 provide that the Judge receiving pension as a retired  
3 Judge shall not engage in the practice of law.

4 DR. BURDETTE: But there are so many other  
5 things he can't do. He couldn't even serve as a campaign  
6 manager for your campaign for Governor and I don't  
7 think that should be in there, but his retirement.

8 JUDGE ADKINS: It is well engaged in the  
9 state now and has been for twenty years and I would  
10 hate to see it changed by what amounts to inadvertance  
11 at this meeting. This has been a very controversial  
12 matter.

13 DR. BURDETTE: Retired Judges must be  
14 political units.

15 JUDGE ADKINS: We don't want the retired  
16 Judges subsidized by the state if you want to put it  
17 that way.

18 MR. MILLER: In that connection, Dale, if  
19 a Judge, as some of them do, retire at a young age and  
20 practice law, is their pension automatically ceased  
21 while they are practicing law or if, as they grow older,
