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member from each county.

MR. SCANLAN: I understand Hal's language to go to senatorial districts.

MR. CLAGETT: Only House of Delegates.

MR. BROOKS: You can't have 150 members and have one each.

THE CHAIRMAN: As I understood it, on the vote we took on point nine we deleted the second sentence which took away the maximum number. There is no maximum now. Senator Hoff's statement is correct. That there is no mathematical impossibility. You may have a practical impossibility of size. Is there a second to Mr. Clagett's motion?

MR. SCANLAN: Can I have that again?

MR. CLAGETT: My motion is the district should be so nearly equal in population as practicable and provide one representative to each --

THE CHAIRMAN: Subject to the limitation there be not less than one representative from each county.

MR. CLAGETT: Exactly.
