

1 member from each county.

2 MR. SCANLAN: I understand Hal's language
3 to go to senatorial districts.

4 MR. CLAGETT: Only House of Delegates.

5 MR. BROOKS: You can't have 150 members and
6 have one each.

7 THE CHAIRMAN: As I understood it, on the vote
8 we took on point nine we deleted the second sentence
9 which took away the maximum number. There is no maximum
10 now. Senator Hoff's statement is correct. That there
11 is no mathematical impossibility. You may have a
12 practical impossibility of size. Is there a second to
13 Mr. Clagett's motion?

14 MR. SCANLAN: Can I have that again?

15 MR. CLAGETT: My motion is the district
16 should be so nearly equal in population as practicable
17 and provide one representative to each --

18 THE CHAIRMAN: Subject to the limitation
19 there be not less than one representative from each
20 county.

21 MR. CLAGETT: Exactly.
